## Work and Training Opportunities for Job Seekers, School Leavers and Gap Year Students

Manpower and Landcare Australia are recruiting participants and team supervisors for major Green Army projects in your area. Green Army is open to all Australian citizens and permanent residents aged between 17-24 years. It is a hands-on, practical environmental action programme that supports local environment and heritage conservation projects across Australia. If you are over 24, you can still apply to be a Team Supervisor.

Joining a Green Army team will provide you with skills, training and experience to improve your employment prospects while you work on projects that generate real and lasting benefits for the environment and Australian Heritage sites.

- Work for 30 hours a week for 20-26 weeks
- Transport, clothing, boots and safety gear provided
- Receive training in First Aid and Work Health and Safety, as well as support to obtain Certificate II qualifications or a nationally endorsed (AQF) skills set
- Undertake a range of activities from planting native seedlings, constructing boardwalks, protecting native wildlife, foreshore and beach restoration, to regeneration of local parks
- You are paid an allowance during your placement in the Green Army

## Get your organisation involved

### Do you have a project guided by local community needs?

Community organisations, environment groups, Indigenous groups and local councils, natural resource management, farming and related groups can apply to host a Green Army project. Projects can take place across urban, regional and remote Australia on public, Indigenous-held, or private land where there is a clear community and environmental benefit.

As a project host you will receive a team of up to nine participants and a team supervisor for 20-26 weeks to carry out activities ranging from planting native seedlings, weed control, re-vegetation of local parks, to construction of boardwalks and walking tracks to protect local wildlife.
